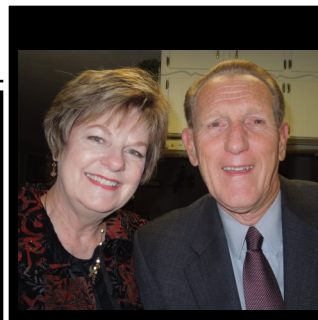

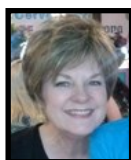

Friday, May 30-God's covering on all travel arrangements: Eyes to see divine appointments while in travel (Matt. 5:14-16)

Saturday, May 31-Continued travel grace; preparation time to gain God's mind, and to hold forth the Word of Life. (Phil. 2:5, 16)

Sunday, June 1- Safe and on-time arrival; rest and quick physical restoration. (Ps. 103:5)

Monday, June 2 – Project begins. Unity among 7 teams; serving together with joy. (Rms. 15:6); Mechanics, equipment, transportation, and warm reception.
