156,000 PEOPLE DIED YESTERDAY

Over 156,000 people around the world died yesterday! In 2013, 56.4 million people died and most of them were not prepared to meet God! The Bible is very clear in Hebrews 9:27 "It is appointed unto man once to die, and then the judgment". This verse reminds us that DEATH is certain and JUDGMENT is coming for each one of us. AMONG THOSE 56.4 million WHO DIED LAST YEAR, was a woman who attended one of our Jesus Film Meetings. PLEASE READ the following testimony sent to us from our ministry coordinator Iwell Phiri:

"This is the testimony of Mrs. Lasiwe Njobvu who was a member of Glory Baptist Church which was planted on May 12 of last year when John and Sharon Booker were

here for the May Project. Mrs. Njobvu was present with her 4 children (her husband had died) in Nsato village for the showing of the Jesus Film. After the film had shown and Pastor John had preached the Gospel message, Mrs. Njobvu's heart was touched and she came forward for the invitation time to receive Christ. After meeting with one of the counselors for prayer, she made arrangements to be baptized on May 12, 2013. When Glory Baptist Church was planted she became a charter member of the church, where she had been serving until her untimely death. Even though she has died, we now have hope that she is with the Lord because she was a believer committed to Him. How will these 4 children be cared for? It will not be an easy life for these children with only their elderly grandmother to care for them. Please keep this family in your prayers." 27,754 Students and Teachers hear Gospel in February!

One of the goals for our ministry in 2014 is to begin reaching the rural schools in Zambia and Mozambique. There are thousands of schools in Zambia and most of them are in rural areas because most people in Zambia make their living from farming the land and raising livestock. God has blessed EPI with another ministry tool which will enable us to reach many more schools this year! Through a generous gift from a very mission minded couple in our church, we have been able to purchase a brand new 200cc motorcycle for Iwell Phiri.. This will not only enable him to do school and prison ministry, but will enable him to travel around to the 34 churches that our ministry has planted and train and encourage these Deacons and Pastors who are leading these congregations of new believers.

During the month of February Iwell was able to conduct 61 school meetings and share a clear and compelling presentation of the Gospel with 27,754 students and teachers. At the end of each assembly an invitation was given for students to trust Christ as Savior and over 20,000 indicated a desire to follow Christ (many teachers responded as well). MORE GOOD NEWS......At each of these 61 schools a teacher was enlisted to lead a monthly <u>SCRIPTURE UNION CLASS</u>. Iwell will be corresponding and following up on these S.U. classes. One of the things we hope to be able to do is to give every student a New Testament who has perfect attendance for an entire school year. We are trusting God to provide the means to purchase these New Testaments over and above the funds needed to continue to reach thousands with the Gospel every month.

We are quickly approaching the departure date for our June project. On May 30th nine members of NRHBC will depart for a 32 hour trip to Livingstone, Zambia. EPI will be partnering with Livingstone Baptist Church led by Pastor Stackson Zulu. LBC is the very first church planted by EPI in Zambia and is located in the Libuya compound, home to the very "poorest of the poor" in Livingstone. This church has been meeting in a school room now for almost 2 1/2 years (sounds like our Cross Church) and through the proceeds raised by our YARD SALE has been able to purchase property on which to build their church building. In addition to doing school ministry, Jesus Film ministry, and door-to-door evangelism, our team of nine people will be assisting LBC in the construction of their church building. The project dates are May 30th–June 14th.
