He even told the headman “those people are not good people, they want to bring death in this village” but the headman allowed us to do the program with a happy heart. Yes before the Jesus film show, we played the gospel music and he was touched by the music. He came to stand 6 meters away from the area. This man was touched by the Jesus Film message and was the first man to come and give his life to Christ. The next morning he came with 23 family members and asked me to tell his family the good news of Christ. All the family were touched with the word of God, were baptized, and have joined Masaku Baptist Church. Thank God for your prays for this bad man, who after hearing the true gospel, has been saved and all his family!
