Every eight seconds, somewhere in the world, another person indicates a decision to follow Christ after watching the "JESUS" film.

Please read the following testimony, sent to us from Iwell Phiri, of a man who was not looking for God but found the Savior of the world after watching the "JESUS" film and he can now cry "Abba Father".

Yes we have reached Mozambique. It was good news to reach Mr. John Tembo and his family. This man of 74 years old, together with his family were not going to have time to hear the word of God. This was an evil man involved in much evil practices including killing people and much bloodshed. But in due time EPI reached Phiya Village. This man did not like our coming, he even told the headman that those people are not good people. They want to bring death into this village but the headman allowed us to do the program with a happy heart. Yes before the Jesus film show we played the gospel music over our sound system and the man was touched by the music. He came to stand 6 meters away from the area. Yes after the Jesus film and the preaching of the gospel message, when the altar call was given, this man was the first man to come and give his life to Christ. The next morning he came with 23 family members and asked me to tell his family the good news of Christ. Yes all the family was touched with the word of God. John and his wife along with the older children all were baptized into Masaku Baptist Church. Thank God for your prayers that this bad man after hearing the true gospel has been saved. Many of the John Tembo's and their families are living in remote villages that cannot be accessed using our new bus because there are no roads leading to their villages...ONLY WALKING TRAILS. We know that God wants us to reach every village, every family, and every

ONE DONOR who wishes to remain anonymous wrote: The reason for the check being an unusual amount goes like this: I had received a letter from my mortgage company saying I had an overage in my escrow and they would send me a refund. I was expecting a small amount for some reason, and the day before the dinner I received a much larger check and could not believe the amount! I started thinking about what I could spend it on. And I remembered the EPI Dinner was the next night. I think God timed it just for that! I love the ratio; for every \$1 given to EPI two people indicate a decision to receive Christ. Most recently, it was so amazing when God provided a much needed bus. When I look at that picture of the bus, I believe that each person who is a contributor to this ministry has an important part of spreading God's WORD in Africa. A clear vision of the ministry was presented at the EPI banquet with detailed information of how God was blessing this ministry and how my husband and I could be a part of it. For instance, an audio BIBLE (the New Testament in Chechewa) for a village costs \$69. I know that when my husband and I contribute to EPI that we are investing in a ministry that shares God's Word with the lost in Africa.

I was thrilled to see the forward thinking and realized God has birthed in John and Sharon a vision of how to reach into the rural villages where the Gospel has never been shared. Exciting stuff!!!!!!

BARBARA CHRISTA shared: Each year when I attend the EPI Dinner, my heart is thrilled with the testimonies of people who were in terrible satanic bondages, who have been given new lives through their faith in Christ. To see videos of people very poor in the riches of this world, now filled with the joy of knowing Jesus as their personal Savior, fills me with delight!
