We have arrived back from Zambia and we are evermore amazed at God's faithfulness. This was our first trip to Zambia in October and God willing it will be our last. Normally we travel in May or June during the COOL SEASON but because of the need to transport equipment we traveled during the HOT SEASON. Our room at the Sinda Motel would finally cool off about 4 A.M. and we were extremely grateful that we only had nine days there. God's hand of blessing and favor was with us as we traveled and we had no major issues with security. All of the equipment was taken out of the EIGHT back packs and placed into our two carry-on bags (they were completely full of equipment). The remaining SIX empty back packs and EIGHT sets of screens, as well as 16 HORN SPEAKERS were loaded into SIX large suitcases along with our clothes (wherever we could fit clothes in). We arrived in Zambia with nothing lost. (Glory to God).

TRAINING AND INTERVIEWING WITH OUR EIGHT MISSIONARIES

Our first training day was spent teaching the men how to use the Jesus Film Backpacks. By the time we returned to the U.S. the men had done **14 Jesus Film Shows** and shared the gospel with almost **20,000 people.** We spent another full day interviewing the eight men and their wives. We marveled at how committed and ready each couple is to do the work of reaching their people with God's Truth. Another full day was spent training the husbands and wives together. It was a great time of getting to know these eight couples and their commitment to fulfilling the GREAT COMMISSION.

THE FIRST MISSIONARY COUPLE IS NOW IN CHAMA

Iwell Phiri along with Raphael and Judith Zulu (and 5 children) arrived in Chama on Wednesday of this week. The house that had been reserved for them was too small for their family of 7 and their first day in Chama (350 KM from Sinda and almost half of that was dirt roads) was spent finding a place to live. The rest of this week has been spent meeting the local CHIEFS and HEADMEN. It is very important to establish a good working relationship within the tribal hierarchy. Iwell called today and said that everyone was very welcoming and excited to receive them. Please keep them in your PRAYERS as they make Chama their new home. Would you pray about providing school fees and uniforms for their school age children.

We have SEVEN more missionary families ready to go. It will take \$2800 to get each couple moved with the bare necessities for their first year.
