Dear Friends,

In 2015 Sharon and I began to notice that our director of EPI ministry in Zambia, Iwell Phiri, had a group of 8 men who seemed to be always around him. We began to question him about this. Iwell then began to share with us the following story:

"EPI is growing fast and will soon become too big for me alone. I am going to need help to accomplish this great work that lies before us. We have many un-reached villages in the Eastern Province of Zambia and Mozambique who have not heard the gospel. I am training these men to help me accomplish this great assignment."

Through that conversation and God's clear leading, EPI would become a missionary sending / planting ministry. These eight men would become the nuclease of a missionary pool that has now grown to over 40 men. All of these men are committed to moving their families to the various parts



of Zambia and Mozambique where the gospel has not reached every village and every person.

GOD'S BIGGER VISION FOR EPI

As we began to move into 2016 it became apparent that God had a much bigger vision for EPI than we had. The story of EPI really begins almost 20 years before God issued the CALL to us in 2009 to

join HIM in taking the gospel to the un-reached people groups of the world. The story of **EPI** actually began in 1990 when God called Iwell Phiri to follow Jesus Christ and he was "born again". Iwell spent the next 10 years serving in his local church and then God called him to be a pastor. Iwell left a good job with a car furnished for him and completed 3 years of seminary training.



He then moved his family to the Eastern Province of Zambia and planted Golgotha Baptist Church.

IWELL THEN BEGAN TO PRAY

As Iwell began to work in Sinda, the "lostness" of the people overwhelmed him. He saw the "fields

white unto harvest" but had no resources to reach them with the true gospel. **IWELL BEGAN TO PRAY!** He began to pray that God would **SEND SOMEONE** to help him get the gospel to the thousands of un-reached villages of Eastern Zambia & Western Mozambique. After **SIX YEARS** of praying God brought Iwell and EPI together in 2012. In 2015 the first 2 missionary families



were planted and in 2016 the **EPI BIBLE SCHOOL** was started with eleven students. Today forty three men are currently enrolled and committed to fulfilling the "Great Commission".
